### Dear Mr. Baldwin and Board Members:

I have reviewed the accompanying statement of financial position arising from transactions of Lane Community College Employees Federation AFT 2417 as of December 31, 2015 and 2014 and the related statement of changes in net assets for the fiscal year then ended. These financial statements are the responsibility of the officers and executive board of Local 2417.

My review consisted of inquiries of the organization's officers and analytical procedures applied to the financial data. Based on my review, I am not aware of any material modifications that should be made to the financial statements referred to above. This letter summarizes my findings and recommendations.

## REVIEW OF INTERNAL CONTROLS

My review of the Local's financial documents revealed certain reportable conditions, which are significant deficiencies in the design or operation of the internal control process for financial matters. These deficiencies could adversely affect the organization's ability to record, process, summarize, and report financial data.

### Cash Disbursements

Supporting documentation for check disbursements should include copies of the disbursement request form, LCCC check with authorized signatures, check stub, and original invoices or other original document indicating the amount owed for legitimate business expenses. The following issues were noted:
